Federal Express Information

Instructions from Federal Express Regarding the Sending of Samples from Outside of the United States of America:

A "Proforma Invoice" should be written on a letter with your personal address or the organization's letterhead

- 1.) It must be addressed to US Customs,
- 2.) This letter should accompany the air bill,
- 3.) The letter must be attached to the outside of the package,
- 4.) The letter must be able to be read in its entirety (no part should be covered up),
- 5.) The letter should be written in the following format:
 - "I, (Your Name), do declare that the following information is true:
 - 1. State whether the material is infectious or non-infectious
 - 2. State origin of material: e.g. Species of the animal
 - * If true, then the letter should also read: "The specimen being sent has not been inoculated with any livestock or poultry disease agents exotic to the United States of America, and did not originate from a facility where work with exotic disease agents, livestock, or avian species is conducted".
